Invitation and call for artists

Le Arti – a show of works about Italy – invites contemporary (living), individual artists to present 1- 3 of their original works about Italy for consideration in the 2020 le Art project as part of Festa Italiana. Each piece will need to be photographed and sent in. No galleries or class work please.

Le Arti and Festa Italiana reserve the right of acceptance.

Categories: Paintings, Drawings, Photography, three-dimensional art of any material. Please, no music, videos, or offensive works; we are after all, a family-oriented event.

Image requirements: The photos should be the first copy, as each consecutive copy deteriorates and will not show well on our web site. Also, saving and resaving JPG files degrades the quality of the image,

Width or height: 2400 pixels (px)

Resolution: 72 pixels per inch (ppi)

Maximum file size: 4 megabytes (Mb) approximately 4096 KB

Color space: RGB

File format: TIFF, PSD or JPEG/JPG. If an artist would like to supply a TIFF or photoshop Photoshop file, we would consider it.

Mandatory labeling: To keep track of each artist and their art the label on each work should be:

Last Name of the Artist_First Name or initial_Name of the artwork_number of the piece submitted (1,2,3).

Example: Paziienza_Giuseppe_Gelati Stop_2

The photo of your artwork will appear with your name which will be a link to your web site. We would not like to use private emails, as there are spambots gathering emails for unscrupulous purposes. This way someone can communicate with you using your contact form.

Festa Italiana Seattle is a 501(c)(3) can accept donor restricted contributions for Le Arti.

All presenters are required to sign the Hold Harmless Agreement 2020
as follows:

If the agreement is not signed, the Exhibitor will not be able to participate in le Arti della Festa Italiana 2020.

In signing this agreement, the Exhibitor promises that the work they are submitting is original, not a copy of some other work or derivative of an existing work without expressed written consent by the original artist, owner or representative of the art.

Exhibitor waives all claims against Festa Italiana, its Board and volunteers. This includes any and all liability for damages, injury, theft or loss incurred before during or as a result of the Le Arti - Festa Italiana event. The Exhibitor will indemnify and hold harmless Festa Italiana from any and all claims, actions or judgments arising from and related to the Exhibitor's participation in Le Arti dell Festa Italiana Seattle and or Festa Italiana Seattle including the acts of the including the acts of the exhibitor's volunteers.

Artists sell their work at their own risk.
